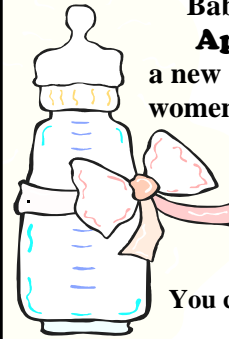


"Listen!" This word appears on a 3 x 5 index card I recently gave those who are participating in our two small group studies. It is a reminder that each and every day we should attempt to listen for the voice of God. The Bible declares, from beginning to end, that our God is a God who speaks. This truth begs the question, are we listening? In his book *Prayers*, Michel Quoist writes, ***"If we knew how to listen to God, we would hear him speaking to us. For God does speak. He speaks in his Gospels. He also speaks through life—that new gospel to which we ourselves add a page each day... If we knew how to listen to God, if we knew how to look around us, our whole life would become a prayer."*** Thomas a' Kempis, the author of the classic work, *The Imitation of Christ*, also recognized that God does, in fact, speak to us and offered the following prayer: ***"Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening... In days gone by the children of Israel said to Moses, 'Speak to us and we shall listen; do not let the Lord speak to us, lest we die.' This is not how I pray, Lord. No. With the great prophet Samuel, I humbly and earnestly beg: 'Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening.' So, do not let Moses speak to me, but you, O Lord, my God, eternal Truth, you speak to me. If I hear your voice, may I not be condemned for hearing the word and not following it, for knowing it and not loving it, or believing it and not living it. Speak, then, Lord, for your servant listens, for you have the words of eternal life. Speak to me to comfort my soul and to change my whole life; in turn, may it give you praise and glory and honor, forever and ever. Amen."*** I challenge you to make this prayer your own. Even more, I challenge you to "Listen!"
